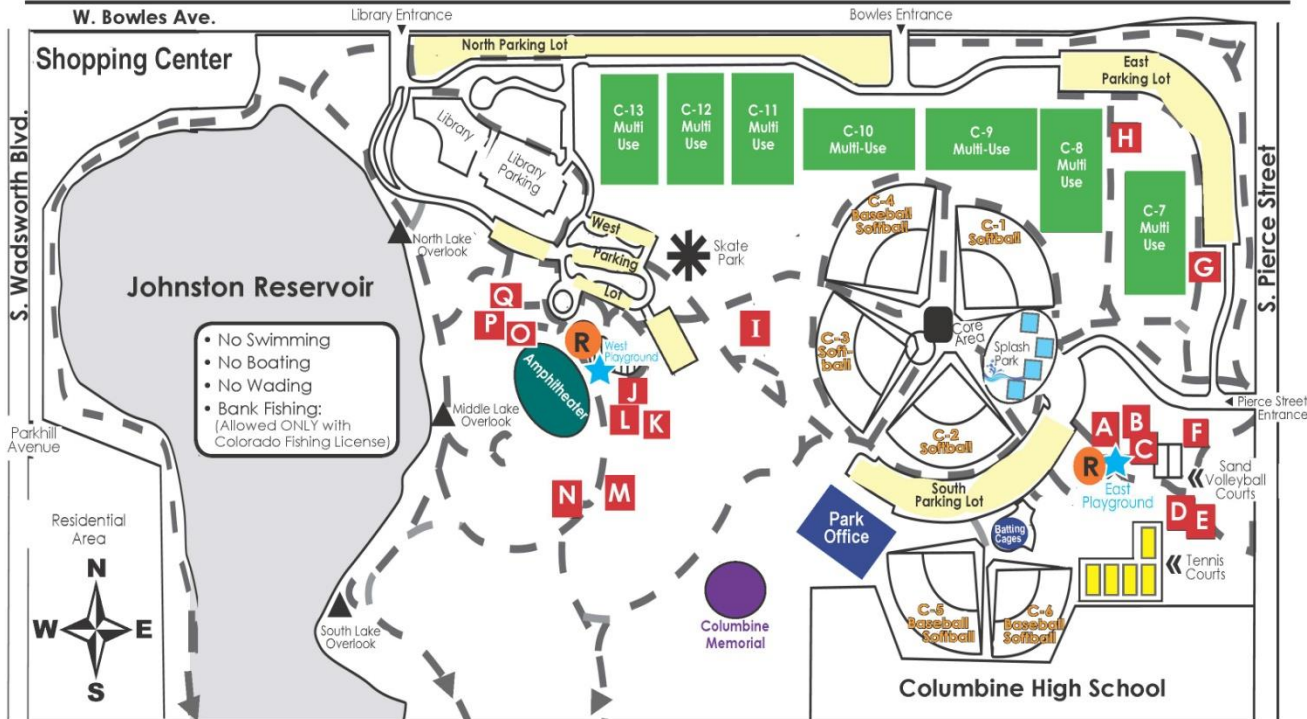

- CLEMENT PARK RULES**
Hours: 5 a.m. – 11 p.m.
- Pets must be on a leash. Be considerate of others – clean up after pets.
