

RESORT VILLAGE OF B-SAY-TAH

BYLAW NO. 12

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT OR REGULATE SMOKING IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS

The council for the Resort Village of B-Say-Tah in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Smoking Bylaw.
2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to prohibit and regulate smoking in buildings and vehicles owned or operated by the Resort Village of B-Say-Tah as it is deemed desirable for the health and welfare of both the inhabitants of the Resort Village of B-Say-Tah and its employees.
3. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "Village shall mean the Resort Village of B-Say-Tah;
 - (b) "Village Building" shall mean the any building owned or operated by the village.
 - (c) "Village Vehicle" shall mean any motor vehicle either owned by the village or with respect to which the village is the lessee.
 - (d) "Smoke" or "Smoking" shall mean the lighting, carrying or smoking of any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or other smoking device.
4. No person shall smoke in a Village Building.
5. No person shall smoke in a Village Vehicle.
6. The Resort Village of B-Say-Tah Administrator is hereby authorized to post in Village Building and Village Vehicles such signs as he/she deems appropriate and only as a courtesy to inform members of the public of any provisions to this bylaw.
7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than thirty five dollars (\$35.00) and not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2000.00).
