Criter	ria for Public Citizen of the Year
conce	ward recipient must make a significant contribution to an area or population of rn to the social work profession. The recipient does not have to be a social worker but it is red. The recipient should make significant contribution such as:
	At-risk or vulnerable populations;
	Quality of life in communities;
	Social issues;
	Act with courage;
	Demonstrate outstanding leadership;
	Exemplify social work values and ethics.
Criter	ria for Elected Official of The Year
The av	ward recipient must:
	Be an elected official serving, at the time of nomination, in public office at
	the local, state, or national level;
	Make a significant contribution to public service while in office;
	Demonstrate leadership in advancing public policy in the area of vulnerable
	populations, civil and human rights, or social welfare;
	Demonstrate leadership on behalf of the protection and advancement of
	social work practice;
	Exemplify social work values and ethics.

## Nature Coast Specific Unit Award: Criteria for Rising to the Challenge Award

The award recipient(s) must make a significant contribution to their community in need. This person or agency has gone beyond normal expectations to meet their community's needs during times of crisis, unrest, or disasters. The recipient(s) does not have to be a social worker, but it is preferred. The recipient(s) must:

Have had a positive impact in the community;
Demonstrated a personal commitment to the benefit of the community;
Performed an outstanding service of acts of giving to meet the needs of the community;
The community has benefited from this person's or group's involvement;
Have had positive and inspiring attributes that serve to encourage others to get involved
