

Drunkard's Path Quilt Block

For our January Workshop, Stephanie will teach you to sew a curve with the Drunkard's Path Quilt Block. Curved piecing can be tricky, but Stephanie's workshop will walk you through each step. Here is a block that can look so different just by rotating each of the smaller blocks. You can use them to make a complete circle or a new twist on the traditional pinwheel.

Finished block is 12"

Materials and Supplies needed:

- To create one block, you will need 2 different fabrics each a fat eighth (9" X 22")
 - o Black – a Fat Eighth (9" X 22")
 - o White – a Fat Eighth (9" X 22")
- Sewing Machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Scissors for cutting fabric
- Pins
