

Schedule of fees:

- Single plot, casket or urn-----\$450.00
- Additional urn in plot, total of three per plot----\$150.00/ea
- Double plot -----\$900.00
- Burial of urn on existing casket/urn plot-----\$150.00
- Single plots will be four ft. wide by eight ft. long.
- Double plots eight ft. wide by eight ft. long.
- Stipends for church services are set by the Archdiocese and are to be paid to the Parish Office.
- Check with the particular funeral home being used for other applicable expenses.

Cemetery Guidelines and Regulations

April 2016

Regulations for Cemetery Operations

-Approval to open new or existing graves is required from the Parish Office or the Cemetery Committee. A burial permit is required before any burial takes place.

-Plots are only assigned when a death occurs. No plots are reserved. A surviving spouse of the deceased may acquire the adjacent plot.

-Burial plots will be selected in accordance with existing policies by the Cemetery Committee.

-Three urns may be accommodated in a single plot.

- Three urns may be accommodated in an existing plot where the first burial was a casket.

-The service provider, selected by the Funeral Home, is responsible for removing all excess material from the cemetery. Any earth, debris etc; placed on adjacent plots will be repaired, raked and left in original condition.

-The family of the deceased is responsible for the landscaping and sodding of the plot and maintaining the plot. There is no perpetual care provided at St. Edward's Cemetery.

-Suitable permanent markers consisting of materials such as granite, marble, or other quality materials approved off by the committee. Headstones are to be no more than 30 inches high including base, and no more than 36 inches wide for a single plot

and 72 inches wide for a double plot.

-The cemetery committee should be contacted before new/replacement headstones/markers are placed.

-Temporary wooden crosses may be used until the site becomes suitable for a permanent marker.

-The planting of shrubs and trees on plots is not permitted. The cemetery committee will choose an appropriate location for the planting of any trees or shrubs that family members/parishioners may donate.

-Objects of any kind including flowers that interfere with grass cutting, maintenance, or the general operation or tidiness of the cemetery will be removed.

-Flower arrangements cannot extend more than 12 inches from the headstone/marker base. Artificial flowers, solar lights and artificial ornaments are discouraged because they create safety hazards and become unsightly.

-For public safety, snow clearing in the cemetery is done as required for funerals.

-A cemetery mass is held each year, usually during July. Families are encouraged to prepare their plots for this occasion.

-The Parish cemetery committee is **not** responsible for any damage due to vandalism or other acts beyond its control.
