

Ordinance Number (721)

An ordinance appropriating certain money's .

Be it ordained by the mayor and commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section One:- that the sum of *Seven hundred and four and 4/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund in the hands of the City Treasurer to pay the bill allowed at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of Nov, 1917 a list of which may be found on page *82 & 83* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Two :- that the sum of *Eight hundred and twenty and 86/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the Water works fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page *83* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Three :- that the sum of *One hundred and thirty and 72/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the Street fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page *84* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Four :- that the sum of *Three hundred and thirteen and 19/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the Electric Light Fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917 a list of which may be found on page *83 & 84* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Five :- that the sum of *Sixty One and 24/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the Semetary Fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the bill allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page *84* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Six :- that the sum of *One and 70/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the funds of Sewer District Number One, in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page *84* of the journal of the proceedings of the board on said date.

Section Seven:- that the sum of *Two hundred and thirty eight and 49/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the fund of Paving District Number *(5)* in the hands of the city treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page *84* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Eight :- that the sum of ~~_____ Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate out of the fund of Paving District Number (5) in the hands of the city treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of November 1917. a list of which may be found on page _____ of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.~~

Section Eight that the sum of *One hundred and seventy and 70/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the ~~_____~~ Department fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 5th day of Nov 1917 a list of which may be found on page *84* of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Nine :- that ~~the sum of _____ Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate~~ the Mayor and city clerk be and are hereby instructed to draw warrants ~~for the sum of _____ Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriate~~ on the city Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in the foregoing sections of this ordinance.

Section Ten that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of commissioners and its approval by ~~Board of commissioners.~~ the Mayor
