

# Safety Procedures Regarding SARS CoV 2

#### Dear clients,

Since I see you in my own home and some of you have weak immune systems, I want to make sure we are all comfortable and safe following-on from the Covid-19 pandemic. I have therefore implemented the following procedures until further notice. I hope that you will feel reassured. Please contact me if you have any questions.

## Your therapist

• I have been vaccinated with the Astra-Zeneca vaccine and wear a mask when out and about in town

# Arrival

- I will greet you warmly but without a handshake or a hug
- Please remove your shoes and leave them on the tray by the front door
- Decibel will probably be her usual self but ideally, she should not be stroked
- Please clean your hands on entering using the touchless sanitiser dispenser by the front door
- Try to minimise the belongings that you bring with you. A box for them will be provided and they can stay safely by the door
- I will provide you with a disposable face mask. If you bring your own, that is also fine

### Treatment

- Proceed directly to the treatment couch and make yourself comfortable
- I will wear my usual uniform but also a fresh face mask and apron
- I will do all the writing on your forms
- The treatment will proceed as usual
- Appointments have been spaced to allow cleaning and airing of the room between clients
- Surfaces and all reusable materials, including the magnets, will be wiped with medical grade wipes between clients.
- The bare vinyl cover of the couch is used as it can be sanitized. Bring a sheet or towel if you want to lie on something
- Payment via BACS or PayPal will be preferred. If cash or cheques are used, I will provide an envelope to put the money away. Please bring the correct amount
- Disposable bottles of water will be provided, if required

## Toilet facilities

- A touchless soap dispenser is available
- Please use the disposable towels provided. The bin is pedal operated
- The cloakroom will be cleaned between clients
