

Justices Hand Victory to Veteran-Owned Small Business Over VA

Washington, D.C. (June 16, 2016) Today the Supreme Court hands a unanimous victory to veteran-owned small businesses and defeat to the Obama administration's Department of Veterans Affairs.

The ruling states that even when the Department of Veterans Affairs meets annual minimum contracting goals for Veterans, that it **shall** abide by The Veterans Benefits, Health Care and Information Technology Act of 2006 including the "Rule of Two" provision.

Rule of Two is a set-aside provision for contracts for veteran-owned small businesses requiring that bidding for major contracts must be limited to Veterans when two or more veteran-owned small businesses are likely to submit reasonable contract bids.
