Battery is a form of domestic violence as defined by Florida law and includes aggravated battery, sexual battery, aggravated stalking, intentional assault, sexual assault, aggravated assault, stalking, false imprisonment, kidnapping or any other action resulting in injury or death of one or more family members by another member. As part of your case plan, you've been ordered to attend and complete a program that addresses one or more of these behaviors.

Family Resource Connection's **Choices & Changes** is a certified batterer's intervention program (BIP) that helps you examine your violent behaviors and anger issues during a 12-week program. Attending this program gives you a fresh perspective about your actions so that you can make changes in your life that allow you to have positive relationships with others. In the classes, you'll learn how to express your needs and communicate in a non-aggressive manner.
