As her loyal performers arrive she just can't bring herself to tell them that this will be the final show - or will it? Great characters, great songs and full of heart.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN:

Mona Clifton – Owner and headliner of The Blue Note Club – Age 35 to 50

One of St. Louis' most recognizable performers. Mona is spitfire who won't take no for an answer but is sensitive and nostalgic. Big voice and big personality. (Alto)

WARREN – Most long time boyfriend – Age 35 to 50

Warren is a devoted boyfriend who has made Mona's life his. He runs the management of the club and when Mona decides to sell the club he handles all the details. Kind but firm business man who also serves as the clubs Master of Ceremony's (Baritone)

CHIP STANBURY – Light and sound guys who longs to get on the stage – Age 20 to 35 Chip is a good old boy from the Midwest who loves everyone and everyone loves him. He runs the lights and sound for the club and hopes to someday get his shot at the stage – which he eventually does – and he is great! (Tenor / Baritone)

HEIDI and HEATHER HAMPTON – Sisters who headline at the club – Age 20 to 35.

Heidi and Heather are a sister act who have been headlining at the club for several years. Sweet and talented they can do it all. (Alto / Soprano)

NIGEL BYTHEWAY – A pompous British comedian – ages 30 to 60

Nigel is a pain in the neck but can play many different characters. Versatile and funny. He is the comic relief of the club and the actual show. (Baritone)
