Registration / Timeline:

Lake will go OFF-LIMITS on 25 April 2024 at midnight until 5am Saturday the 27th of April.

Lake Waco is currently 0.29 feet high. Water Temperature is 66 degrees and stained.

Saturday 27 April 2024:

Tournament Day

- Check-in and Boat Number draw begins at 5:30am, at the Official Launch Site, the Twin Bridges Park Boat Ramp.
 - a) For safety reasons and to comply with the Youth Sports Safety Act, all boats must have <u>3 people on</u> the boat, <u>2 student anglers and a Boat Captain</u>. If for whatever reason an angler cannot make it, that team must provide an observer.
- The Official Launch site will be Twin Bridges Park Boat Ramp area.
- The Official Launch Time is Safe Light. You may put in beginning at 5:00am.
 - a) All Boat Captains need to be mine full of the <u>"No-Wake Zones"</u> and be sure you are not cutting off other anglers as you leave the ramp area.
 - b) All Boat Captains must observe any, and all posted "No Fishing Areas" / "No Boat Areas."
- The Official weigh-in site will be Twin Bridges Park Boat Ramp area.
- The Scales will open at 2:00pm.
- Anglers must be in line by 2:30pm with their catch. Any angler coming after 2:30pm cut off will incur a late penalty.
 - a) Anglers and Boat Captains that do not come to the weigh-in site must text 254-368-0294 once they are off the water.

Awards

- Scholarships, Awards, and Prizes will be awarded after weigh-in (approximately 3:00pm).
- Awards will be given to the 1st thru 4th place Teams, including Big Bass, plus one place for each 10 entries.
- We will also award this seasons Team of the Year Award
- We will also be awarding this season small, medium, and large school / club awards.
- This season's Championship winning Junior Team will receive scholarship money.
- We will be awarding a Big Bass prize on both the high school side and the junior angler side.
