

A Masterpiece of Mercy

Through the extraordinary generosity of our Columbiettes, the parish of Ss. Cyril and Methodius in Deer Park has been graced with a gift that does more than decorate a wall. It pierces the heart. This Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026, during our solemn evening Mass, we had the distinct honor of blessing **our new crucifix**, a work of art that will serve as a silent, powerful preacher for generations to come.

This is not merely a piece of wood; it is a masterpiece of sacred liturgy crafted by the hands of Jorge Luis Villalba Terán. Coming to us from San Antonio de Ibarra, Ecuador, Villalba Terán is an artist who understands that to carve the Divine, one must first understand the human.

As an art historian, I am struck by how this sculpture captures the *Quito School* tradition: that unique blend of Spanish Baroque intensity and anatomical realism. But as your pastor, I want to invite you to look closer at what this image says to our souls.





An Artistic and Theological Reflection

Look at the posture of the Christ. Notice the profound, almost gravitational pull of His head. In many traditional crucifixes, the Lord is depicted looking up to the Father or out at the world. Here, Villalba Terán gives us a "Christ of the Last Breath." The head bowed low is the ultimate gesture of *kenosis* - the self-emptying love described by St. Paul in his Letter to the Philippians, 2:5-11. On the cross, Jesus gave us everything; there was nothing left to hold up.

The anatomical realism - the tension in the arms, the visible ribcage, the bruising of the skin - serves a vital theological purpose. It reminds us that our salvation was not won by a ghost or a myth, but by a Man of flesh and blood who felt the splinters of the wood and the cold of the iron.

Perhaps most striking is the "S-curve" of the body. It creates a sense of movement, as if the cross is not a static object of death, but a living tree. The contrast between the rugged, hand-hewn texture of the Ecuadorian wood and the refined, smooth realism of the corpus tells us the story of the Gospel: that out of the roughness of our sin and the cruelty of the world, God carves the perfect beauty of His mercy.

When you look upon this crucifix, do not just see a victim. See a victor who fought the battle of Calvary with the weapons of love and sacrifice. The Columbiettes have given us more than a donation; they have given us a window into the Passion.


As Bishop Fulton Sheen once said, "The cross is the only ladder by which we can rest our souls in the heart of God." Thanks to our Columbiettes and the skilled hands of Señor Villalba Terán, that ladder now stands more clearly before us than ever before.

May the Lord bless you for your devotion, and may this image of His love guide us through this Lenten season and beyond.



Some time ago Fr. Anthony came to the Columbiettes and asked us if we would like to donate a new cross for the Church. We overwhelmingly said yes. On Ash Wednesday Fr. Anthony blessed the new cross & thanked the Columbiettes for their generosity. When you initially look at the cross it is different from what we usually see as Jesus depicted on the cross. I have learned that the old type cross is called "sleeping Jesus" The new cross is an actual depiction of how Jesus really looked on the cross.

Fr. Anthony sought out a very talented artist to make this real depiction of the cross for all parishioners of Ss. Cyril & Methodius to enjoy. Below is some background info on this artist. We **thank Fr. Anthony** for bringing such a beautiful piece of work to us to enjoy for many years.

Jorge Luis Villalba Terán is an Ecuadorian wood sculptor from [San Antonio de Ibarra](#), renowned for sacred carvings that unite Baroque intensity with refined anatomical realism. Active since the 1980s, he gained international recognition when his Cristo del bosque won second place at the [Taiwan International Wood Sculpture Competition](#) in 2013. Trained from childhood and inspired by master [Daniel Reyes's](#) legacy, he continues creating commissions for churches across [Ecuador](#), [Spain](#), Rome, Malta, and [Chile](#) while promoting his town's carving tradition.



On Wednesday, February 11th we delivered **176** filled boxes to Birthday Wishes in Hicksville. This far exceeded our expectations. Last year our goal was 50 we delivered 76.
