

# ALEX LEE GREGORY

## 1904-1993

Alex Lee Gregory, 89, well-known for his work with polygraphs in police cases prior to residing in Sebawaing for the past 20 years, died Thursday, Nov. 11, in Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe, following a lengthy illness.

He was born in Howell, the son of Edward Payson and Pitti Itala (Smith) Gregory. He was married to Clara Louise Likon on Oct. 5, 1928, in Sebawaing. She survives him.

Mr. Gregory was a graduate of the University of Michigan, and had been in private practice as a lie detector expert in Chicago for many years. He was a consultant with the late Eric Stanley Gardner, well-known detective writer who created the Perry Mason books and TV character. Later he moved his practice to Detroit from where he retired in 1973. The Gregorlys then moved to Sebawaing.

Mr. Gregory was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebawaing.
