CALL TO ORDER: The Special Council Meeting of with the BIA Western Agency Office on Thursday, July 17, 2025 was called to order at 2:00 pm.

ROLL CALL:

SLPT Council: Chairwoman Randi Lone Eagle, present; Vice-Chairwoman, Nedra Crane, present; Secretary/Treasurer, Philip Frank, present; Council Member Scott Cory Burdette, present; and Council Member, Cherice Trejo, present.

BIA Western Agency: Cheryl Sam, Acting-Superintendent and Margot Dyer

Ms. Sam's three goals with tribal leaders are the following.

1. Schedule meet and greets with each tribe in the month of July.
2. Acknowledge the issues and focus on one for the next 90 days for each tribe.
3. Provide an opportunity for the Western Nevada Agency staff to give an update of case load and an educational process of each department to each tribe.

The Western Nevada Agency went from ten to six staff members. Ms. Dyer works with the 638 contracts such as CTGP, ATG, Higher Education, Fisheries, Roads, and Range. They will have same contracts and new numbers.

Annual funding agreements will come to the tribes with modifications. SLPT narratives will now be on an annual basis.

They requested a scope of work for the Endangered Species fund in the amount of \$49,000.00.

For SLPT renewals, BIA requests that SLPT submit:

1. Letter of interest for renewals
2. Scope of work-changes or no changes
3. Budget
4. Any new position descriptions
5. Resolutions

Per Ms. Dyer, Summit Lake never had a social services department.

Law enforcement- Summit Lake will continue to work with Mr. Hubanks and his team.

Ms. Sam sent an email on their phone system that was down. Phone numbers to the agency will not change and she provided staff phone numbers and emails so if SLPT needs to contact the BIA, they could get a hold of staff.

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Summit Lake will work with Utahna on the process on probate cases and who to contact, overview of probate and they will be sending the list of the whereabouts in the mail to all the tribes.

We look forward to a possible meeting date to meet with all the departments of the BIA office.

Ms. Sam also confirmed that the Western Nevada Agency office is not closing nor will the Eastern and Phoenix Area offices.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:00pm
