 - 1. Lifeguards certification is setup for Spring Break.
 - 2. There has been no decision made as to what extent the repairs will be on the pool going forward.
- C. Recreation Center
 - 1. Fitness Classes- YOGA, SPIN, CHAT AND CARDIO, DONNA BRUMMEL- numbers are up but expect a decline going into February and March.
 - 2. Recumbent elliptical costing roughly \$4000.00 has been added. It is commercial grade.
 - 3. More treadmills and elliptical machines need to be replaced. Waiting on budget approval. Looking at June to replace.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. 24 hour access- The ball is rolling on getting the facility set up for 24 hour access. Purchase cameras. There are still a lot of details to get ironed out, still looking to find the best software solutions and most suitable fee structure.
