Pastor's Corner

Advent has started. Did you know that for the Church, Advent marks the official start of the year (not January 1st)? Since we're at that kind of moment, I want to ask, "How should we start?" As I also consider that question through the month of December, I do have one way I'd like to start. I want to ask for some *help*. I've been a pastor long enough to know if you would like to motivate people to join a team, making a "pitch from the pulpit" during announcements just doesn't get it done. I will try to express the need by word of mouth too, but since the "*Let me think about it*"s are beginning to pile up, I'd thought I'd share it here. There are a lot of things our various ministry teams are in need of right now, so if you can't help out in the very specific way I'm about to ask, please, *please, don't wait to be asked*. Instead, approach one of the many teams – the *Upkeep Team*, the *AV Team*, the *Children's Church Teachers*, the *Praise Band* – just because you don't think you have the "abilities" needed for their work, that doesn't mean you can't connect somebody to them. But don't count yourself out – what would have happened if Moses, Gideon, Jeremiah, Peter (all people who told God, "you got the wrong guy; you don't want me for that"), what would have happened if they insisted someone

else do it?

Anyway, as many of you know I wear Puckety's "youth director" hat for about 18 students who we've been investing in for the last couple years. This coming February I would like to take them to the **Pine Springs Winter Retreat**. What we need are *three* (3) adult chaperones who can spend the weekend with them: 1) drive a car of kids (and their bags) to the camp, 2) join me as a chaperone for the weekend – the camp provides the program but we will need to help monitor and engage – fair warning the cabins have heat and bathrooms, but the sleeping quarters are modest – and 3) help transport the kids back on Sunday. The caravan would leave around 5:30 PM on Friday Feb. 6th, and return Sunday (8th) in the afternoon. The Church would pay your registration as our thanks to you for being a chaperone. There have been years we haven't been able to go, even though we had 6-7 kids interested, because there weren't enough adult chaperones.

Yes, excursions for laser tag and mall scavenger hunts are great, but it's events like weekend retreats at Pine Springs where kids, who have been inching little by little closer to Christ, have a special encounter with the gospel, which can lead to a more vital relationship to Christ, which can lead to a whole different kind of life, which glorifies God. I don't want our kids – especially ones just a year or two away from graduating and entering the secular/college world – to miss opportunities where their spiritual roots can grow deeper, so they can face those times, and beyond, with a better foundation; with the *sure foundation*, of Christ.





**From the Hearts & Hands of Puckety's Elders, Deacons, and Leaders** [Some highlights of the November Session meeting]

**\*Natural Gas Lease** – Through the hard work – mostly of Chuck West (“Thank you, Chuck!”), Puckety has formally entered into the lease. The signing amount will be at \$3,000/acre, which will come to approximately \$19,000 and thereafter a 17% net royalty on extraction returns. Please note a result of this will involve a change to the official documentation of our name to “Puckety Presbyterian Church” as some older legal documents do not reflect the same name. Please look for the date of the Congregational + Corporation Meeting where we will vote to make that official

**\*The Upkeep Team** – You probably have noticed that we have a completely new roof on Faith Hall and adjacent sheds! All our buildings now match! In addition the Upkeep Team will oversee the demolition of the old sidewalk to Faith Hall (Scheftic Construction) so that a new ramp and railing can be constructed and installed – within the first week or two of December.

There are many other tasks on the “project list” of the Upkeep Team (such as a subcommittee working with the Fellowship Team to research and buy new chairs for Faith Hall) – over a dozen. They have developed a prioritization system. Some of the projects near the ‘top’ of the list include the electric lights in the chancel area and the Faith Hall kitchen countertops. Of course, they would welcome others to join the team – more “heads and hands” will be of great benefit – particularly if there is someone who may be able to help with cemetery administration.

**\*Budget** – the Session reviewed and approved the finalized 2026 Budget, which will be presented to the congregation on Sunday December 21<sup>st</sup> at the Annual Cong. Meeting

**\*Outreach – Locally**, we continue to provide weekend meals to students in our district (increased from 23 to 29 because of the effects of the gov’t shutdown). Puckety was responsible for the distributions in November, and we want to thank Matt and Denise Wehrle for their extra efforts – Matt went shopping 3 different times to make sure we had sufficient inventory for our packing and drop-offs! We also thank our packing crew (including Margie Hazlett, Vicky Eckman, and a mystery helper!)



**Christmas in the Woods** On Saturday Dec. 13<sup>th</sup> – from 1 to 4 PM at Kotecki Park – join us for a special community event - Puckety is one of the main participants. We already have a choir of over a dozen carolers (1:00 to 1:45), and we will have a Craft Table for the entire time – the crafts are simple to construct; but we need a couple more volunteers to help with the table so each shift is only 1 hour and no team gets too cold! Come help the children and families create something they can take home to remember the reason for the season – contact Wiebke at 724-799-3323 to see which shift you can help with. This event will also be an excellent opportunity to do the following: 1) make and donate some baked goods that can bless attenders, 2) connect and invite attendees to our Advent and Christmas Eve

services, 3) tie in the Christian faith aspect of the season with the community that may not see it as much.


**Globally** – Please start planning for the upcoming collection for *MUST* which will be over multiple Sundays from mid-January to early February. Note: by action of the Session, whatever donation is made to *MUST* during the collection from January 18<sup>th</sup> through February 8<sup>th</sup>, it will be matched from the Reserve Fund, so we can maximize the impact of our gift to our missionary partners. Please make a note on the “Memo” line of your checks – “*MUST* collection.” You can also designate your giving on Puckety Church’s Vanco giving page – there is a clearly marked category for *MUST* - which can be accessed from our website’s giving page or the QR code in the pews.

**\*Puckety’s Deacons** We want to thank the Deacons for collecting 27 Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes. We also want to thank them for all the Thanksgiving food baskets they put together and delivered! All 30 “Angel Tree” tags were taken the first Sunday the tree was up – thank you for everyone’s generosity. **A Devotional for You - Exodus 12:5** – “Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old, and you shall keep it and care for it until the appointed time” **Luke 2:12** - “And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths (the wrappings for a sacrificial lamb) and lying in a manger.”

Probably for the rest of my life, I will remember my trip to Israel in April of 2023 (not the year I went, I'll forget that by next year). No, I mean the places I went with fellow pilgrims. For example, a small cathedral in Bethlehem marks the traditional birthplace of Jesus. Behind a high altar there is marble stairway (see picture) descending into a cave, a little cavern lit by silver lamps. For some reason, this hushed and intimate place impacted me more powerfully than the mighty Church of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem with its extremely ornate stations and tomb of Jesus. In the *Church of the Nativity*, you can enter the main edifice and admire the ancient church. You can also descend into the cave grotto, where a star embedded on the floor recognizes the birth of the King. There is one stipulation, however. You have to **stoop**. For both the traditional entrance of the church – the door is so low you can't go in standing up (yes, even for me!) - as well as the entrance to the cave where Jesus was traditionally put in the manger, you must lower yourself. And isn't the same true of the Christ? You can see the world standing tall, but to witness the



Savior, you have to get on your knees. It is only through humility that we can begin (and I mean *just begin*) to glimpse the glory of God in Christ. There is no way our little minds can comprehend the love of God, but that didn't keep him from coming. Max Lucado writes, “From the cradle in Bethlehem to the cross in Jerusalem we’ve pondered the love of our Father. What can you say to that kind of emotion? Upon learning that God would rather die than live without you, how do you react? How can you begin to explain such passion?” You start with what the shepherds did after they saw that baby wrapped in the tools of their trade – by telling the wonderful story to any who would listen, and trust in God to change the world.
