Vera Cook, age 78, of Elkton, died Wednesday, January 6, at the Martin Luther Memorial Home, Holt after a long illness.

She was born February 15, 1920 in Oliver Twp at the home of her parents, the late William and LaReatha (Stout) Abbe.

On November 29, 1945, she was united in marriage to Orville B. Cook in Elkton. He preceded her in death, June 20, 1947.

Vera lived in Elkton most of her life and was employed at the Elkton State Bank from 1947 to 1970. In 1970, she left the Elkton bank and became one of the organizing officers of First National Bank (now known as Signature Bank), retiring in 1985 as Vice President.

Vera was a member of the Elkton United Methodist Church and Women's Society and a past member of the Elkton Women's Civic Club.

Surviving are one daughter, Marjorie Stine and two grandsons, Ben (Mary) and Rob, all of East Lansing; her sister, Ethel Alexander of Elkton and several nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death were one granddaughter, Rochelle Richmond and one brother, Kenneth Abbe.
