Please contact us on a one to one basis if you have financial difficulties with this policy and we will do our best to work with you.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel Insurance for Overnight trips - Travel insurance is available for you to purchase at time of reservation. You are able to pick and choose the different types of insurance you would like. If you have a pre-existing condition, you will need to get your insurance 14 days from making your initial deposit. Deposit becomes non-refundable at 60 days prior to departure date. 60-46 days prior to departure, there is a cancellation fee of 50% of total price, 45-31- days prior to departure, there is a cancellation fee of 75% of total price & 30-0 - days of departure there is a cancellation fee of 100% of total price.
