ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE DENYING MOTION TO PERMIT INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL

(Issued December 2, 2015)

- 1. On November 30, 2015, counsel for Ted Hein, Dean Brockway, Buffalo Wallow LLC, Western Montana Water Users Association LLC, Gene Erb, Jr., Paul A. and Barbara Grieco, Mary K. Matheidas, Sheila M.C. Vallejo (Petitioners), filed a motion to Permit an Interlocutory Appeal to the Commission of the Chief Judge's November 13, 2015 Order¹ denying Petitioners' motion to intervene out-of-time (Motion). Petitioners reiterate the arguments made in their prior motions.
- 2. The Chief Judge has carefully reviewed Petitioners' Motion and finds that Petitioners have shown no new grounds in their Motion to persuade the Chief Judge to modify his original ruling.
