TEAM-UP, Teacher Education Alliance, Mines-UNC Partnership, is designed to give Mines students a streamlined pathway to Colorado teacher licensure in science and/or math. The timeline for completion depends upon the student's academic schedule.

Program Notes

- UNC PSY 349 and EDF 366 (with grades of C or better) have been approved by the Mines Liberal Arts and International Studies Division to count as an H&SS mid-level elective.
- Other UNC courses (with grades of C or better) taken prior to graduation will count for a student's unfulfilled free electives.
- A passing score on the appropriate licensure exam (Praxis II: Math 5161 or Science 0435/5435) is required for EDFE 130.

Eligibility for Classes

All current Mines students, undergraduate or graduate, may register for the initial TEAM-UP courses without applying to the licensure program. Students must be in good standing at Mines (GPA of 2.0) to take initial TEAM-UP courses. In order for TEAM-UP courses to count toward licensure, students must earn at least a C.

Registering for Classes

Current Mines undergraduate students will register for classes through Mines' Office of the Registrar using the Mines-UNC registration form available from your TEAM-UP advisor. Mines graduate students and Mines' alumni will register through UNC's online registration system (URSA) at <https://cas.unco.edu/cas/login?service=https%3a%2f%2fursa.unco.edu%2fdefault>. Talk to your TEAM-UP advisor if you need assistance.

Applying for the Program

All current Mines undergraduate or graduate students, and individuals who hold a baccalaureate degree from Mines earned within ten years may apply for the program.

To apply: Submit letter of interest and transcripts to stephanie.fanselow@unco.edu

1. Enroll in EDFE 125.
2. Submit a 500 to 750-word letter of interest that includes:
 - a. your reasons for exploring teaching,
 - b. experiences you have had with secondary-aged youth (coaching, tutoring, etc.),
 - c. your full name, and
 - d. either your date of birth or UNC Bear number.
3. If an undergraduate student, submit an unofficial transcript with cumulative Mines GPA. If a graduate student or alum, submit copies of official transcripts from each college attended.
