

# REGULATIONS

4. The boys will not be able to visit the dormitories of the girls, nor the girls the ones of the boys.
5. Campers will only use the phone in allowed hours.
6. Hair dryers, fans, radios, cell phones, walkie-talkies, magazines, video games, or any electronic equipment (T.V., I-pod, DSI, etc.) are not allowed.
7. During the day it is allowed to wear "shorts" or pants, no type of "shorts", "jogging / bicycling shorts" or "boxers". Clothing is required to sleep (you can not sleep in underwear). At night appropriate clothes for services will be --Boys: pants or shorts and shirts-- Girls: dresses or skirt and blouse, shorts, or jeans - for the pool: only a one-piece swimsuit is allowed (no "bikinis" or "tankinis" are allowed), and belly navels, mini-skirts, "skorts", "spaghetti straps" or "halter tops" or any clothing that superiors may decide is not appropriate. (Casual clothes are required for 4 days, 3 nights of service, and a campfire night which is recommended jeans and tennis.)
8. No camper may be out of their bedroom after the indicated time. You cannot leave the camp or be out of sight of the group.
9. It is necessary that they meet the schedule on time.
10. Visits are not allowed during the camp. For visits is only the last day, July 26 during the campfire time.
11. In case the camper does not comply with the regulations of the camp they will be sent home, without refund of registration.
