1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place Certificates in both TRADITIONAL and DIGITAL styles will be presented for each club scrapbook that demonstrates outstanding use of theme, organization, creativity, originality, artistic compilation, and coverage of club activities. Participating clubs must present their scrapbooks to the Newsletter & Scrapbooks Awards Chair @ AzFRW Registration area **by 4pm on Thurs, Oct 24th**.

DEFINITIONS:

TRADITIONAL SCRAPBOOK is any album that is created with various layers of papers, adhesives, and tangible embellishments.

DIGITAL SCRAPBOOK is any album created completely by computer and PRINTED in a book format OR pages printed to be placed in a book or binder for display.

The following criteria will be used to judge the scrapbooks:
