- A responsible adult must be present with the child, both inside & outside the ring.
- Dogs must have an AKC registration number.
- **All AKC fully recognized Miscellaneous Class & FSS breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing & All American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.**
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

★ A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. To obtain junior identification number contact juniors@akc.org

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

SHOW SITE AVAILABILITY:

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 4:00 pm, Thursday. Every effort will be made to obtain earlier access to the set-up area. Check the Entry Confirmation/Judging Program for the most current information regarding access times. Dogs must be removed from the show site by 8:00 pm Sunday.

TICKETS:

1. There is no admission charged to exhibitors for these shows.
2. Exhibitor's identification tickets will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank and should be received within a reasonable time prior to the show. Contact the Superintendent if tickets are not received to make sure you are entered. Superintendent can provide this information only to exhibitors who have utilized the exhibitor code provided on the entry form.
3. Tickets returned by the post office marked "undeliverable" will be held at the Superintendent's office.

FACILITY RULES:

1. It is a violation of state law to bring alcohol, illegal drugs & weapons onto the Arizona State Fairgrounds. Any person(s) violating the state law will be escorted off the premises by Fairgrounds security.
2. Smoking is not permitted in any of the buildings in accordance with state statute.
3. There will be NO vehicles allowed at any time in any of the show buildings.
4. Food and beverage stands will be available on the showgrounds.
5. No food sales by vendors or exhibitors allowed.
6. Water is available at this site.
7. No glass containers are allowed on the property.
8. Violations of rules & regulations or inappropriate behavior towards Arizona State Fairgrounds employees, Show Committee & officials or fellow exhibitors may subject any participant in this event to disciplinary action by the Show Committee.

CRATING, SETUPS & EXERCISE AREAS:

1. Security will be provided. However, dogs, equipment or personal items left on the show grounds are the responsibility of each exhibitor. Neither the Superstition Kennel Club, Inc., any of the participating specialty clubs nor the Arizona State Fairgrounds is responsible for lost or stolen dogs or equipment.
2. Unreserved inside crating space is provided on a first come, first served basis. Roping off unused crating space is strictly prohibited & will be removed by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates & any other remedies it may deem necessary for consolidating space.
3. NO ELECTRICAL CORDS allowed in aisles.
4. Exercise pens allowed outdoors only. Pens must be set up on polyethylene sheeting if mats or carpet are not used. Sawdust or comparable absorbent material used to cover the sheeting must be disposed of along with the sheeting when vacating your setup space.
5. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up his (her) own setup area on a daily basis. Remember to bring a broom.
6. Grooming & crating space is available in all buildings & outdoors.
7. Temporary crating of any breed at ringside is allowed only while that breed is being shown. This rule will be strictly enforced. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
8. Dog bathing facilities will be available on the show grounds. Only cold water will be available.
9. Dogs may not be left unattended in exercise pens or on grooming tables.
10. Dogs may be left overnight in the buildings.
11. Electricity is not available to unreserved setup spaces.
12. Generators may be used only outside the buildings in designated parking areas.
13. All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the show grounds, except when in an exercise pen or obedience ring. Due to safety concerns, the use of retractable/flexi-leads on the show grounds is not permitted during show hours. All dogs must be on a lead not to exceed six (6) feet in length and under control at all times.

General Parking

1. All exhibitors should enter the Arizona State Fairgrounds at the gate located at 17th Ave & McDowell.
2. Day of Show parking is \$8.00 per day (Friday thru Sunday), per vehicle. Oversize vehicles (RV's, Box Vans) pay \$16.00 per day. If you need to leave the grounds for any reason, have your parking stub stamped at the gate for re-entry without charge. If your parking stub is not stamped, you will be charged for parking each time your vehicle comes through the gate.
3. 3-Day Parking Passes may be purchased for \$13.00 on site Thursday after 3:00 pm or ordered prepaid by mail. The fee without a pass is \$8.00 per day. There is no charge for parking on Thursday. Discounted passes may be ordered by mail before February 12, 2020 & will be delivered by mail. A stamped, self-addressed envelope is to be included with payment. Checks for parking passes are to be made payable to Superstition Kennel Club & mailed to **Connor Arbuthnot, 4263 E Hope St, Mesa AZ 85205.**
4. Parking lots are open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm each day.
5. The person with the handicap license must be present in the vehicle to use a handicap space.
6. No set-ups, grooming, x-pens or awnings in Day of Show Parking. Absolutely only one space per vehicle. No exceptions.
7. Reserved day of show/overnight parking is available for exhibitors wishing to set up grooming tables and exercise pens adjacent to their vehicles. See Reserved Parking Rules & Reserved Parking Application.

DOGS LEFT IN PARKED CARS

All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs, their members or agents in the event a vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. In the event that it becomes necessary to rescue an animal from a parked car on the show grounds or parking areas immediately surrounding the show grounds, the Superstition Kennel Club, Inc. will not be held liable for any damages incurred as a result of rescuing the animals. Furthermore, if the rescue has to be performed by virtue of negligence, the owner, agent or any other person responsible for the rescued animal WILL be subjected to an Event Committee hearing as approved by the rules of the AKC.

Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.

The Superstition Kennel Club, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Lagotti Romagnoli, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeens, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breed may be judged on a ramp or on a table: Mudi

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

NEUTERED DOGS & SPAYED BITCHES MAY COMPETE IN VETERAN CLASSES AT THESE SPECIALTIES

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

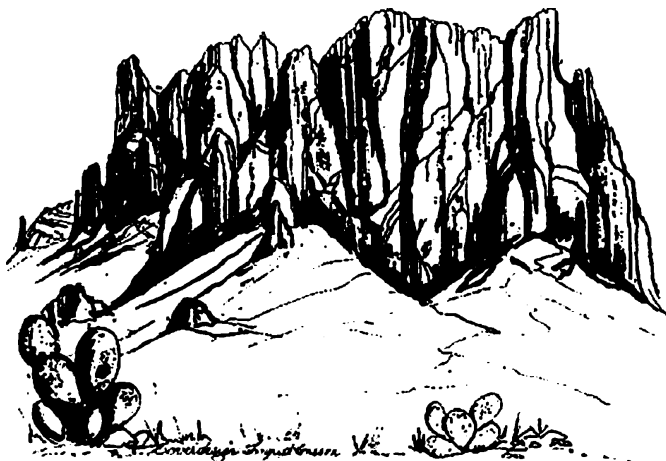

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
