Supervisor May called the board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting.

Supervisor May introduced Mr. & Mrs. James Graham, from Quakertown Road. Mr. Graham wanted to bring information to the Town Board regarding the issues that they have had recently regarding Frontier Telephone services. On September 19, 2022, a lightning strike hit the phone line going into their home. Mr. Graham contacted Frontier and made an appointment for the 26<sup>th</sup> of September, Frontier never showed for the appointment. At this time, they had no phone or internet. We made another appointment, 5 weeks away, the 29<sup>th</sup> at 3:30pm. They were also a no show. We contacted Senator Gallivan on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and called a total of 8 times and schedules 8 different times, all of which no one ever showed up to the appointments to repair our service. We called again and they said they would “fix it today, remotely”, and it was obvious that the wires were fired. We then went to the Public Service website and obtained their number and contacted them, a complaint was filed

with the office. We are frustrated and dismayed regarding the limited service and the lack of service, that we may have in this area, and we need to have service to our home, for if there is an emergency, we can not contact anyone!

Supervisor May thanked the Grahams for coming and informing the Board of what is occurring in our Town.

Plow equipment is on, new employee; Joe is doing very well. Bug Tozier will come back part time in January. Were fixing tile. Salt bid, compass salt won, \$55.89/ton – Compass; \$57.15/ton-American Rock Salt. I would like to go with American Rock Salt d/t the increase in water in the compass salt and the consistency of their product. On a motion by Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Flint to go with American Rock Salt d/t a better product (as compass has an increase of water and a poor consistency of product. Town Clerks Report:

The Towns total revenue for the month of October was \$797.00, \$465.00 for Zoning, \$297.00 for dog licenses, \$25.00 for Scrap license and \$10.00 for late fees. We had 3 new licenses and 22 renewal licenses. To the general fund, \$591.00, Dogs were \$91.00, Late fee - \$10.00, \$25.00 for Scrap license and \$465.00 for Zoning. We disbursed \$165.00 to Wyoming County, \$41.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs.

Correspondence: Received information from Mr. Di Matteo's office regarding a trust account. Contacted the office and they are looking into this correspondence.
