DESCRIPTION: FASCO was a highly regarded bow company in the 1960-70s that produced high-end target and hunting bows. This rare Fasco Model 55 is in excellent condition. Great looking and performing recurve. This vintage bow oozes quality. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The riser is in superior condition for its age, but the limbs do show some normal wear and tear. The lower limbs had finish loss and considerable wear, so I completely stripped and refinished the lower limbs. In the process the bow's handwritten specs could not be saved. So the decal and specs are a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. If you are looking for a high quality, fast, and highly accurate higher poundage hunting bow, this would be a good choice.

Note: I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 20 hours) to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed.

Comes with a new black B-55 16 strand Dacron endless loop string.
