2021 City Wide cleanup- This year's City-Wide Cleanup was another huge sucess. There was over 30 tons of garbage hauled away and over 5 tons of metal recycled. Thank you to everyone who participated in helping keep the City beautiful! We look forward to seeing you next year!

The 2021 street repairs have been put out for bid to local contractors. We strive to keep the Citys streets the best we can with preventative Maintenace and repairs. Mulberry Drive west, and Freedom Lane will be getting a complete re-surfacing to repair the settling areas, de laminating, and large cracks. Leisure lane will be re-sealed to help pro long the life of this heavily traveled street. While these construction projects may be an inconvenience for a little while, it will be nice to have new street surfacing. We will keep the residents informed as to when the construction will begin as the projects are set to be completed by fall. Thank you for your patience!

Yard waste- Please keep in mind that the Summerset yard waste areas are for SUMMERSET RESIDENTS ONLY. If the containers are full, please take your yard waste back home until the following day. Large pickup truck loads, and commercial yard waste needs to be hauled directly to the Rapid City landfill. If you are caught dumping yard waste on the ground because the containers are full you will immediately be fined \$1500. These containers are clearly labeled as to where the full line is. Please do not fill the containers over this line as it makes it extremely difficult to transport. Thank you for cooperation and efforts to ensure we can continue to offer this service.





Each program counts as 10 points toward summer reading prizes!




Bluestockings Virtual Book Club
