**THANK YOU, THANK YOU**, to all who donated making it **POSSIBLE for us to purchase Purvis Store**. We are scheduled for the closing in just a few days, on September 30. Forty-two of you donated, 26 live in the Esmont zip code! The total collected, including the \$5000 match, is \$29,700. The purchase price of the property is \$28,500. We are now seeking grant funds for much needed landscaping and to patch the roof and shore up the bowed wall. Donations are always welcome.

We also want to thank **Steve Morris**, an Esmont resident, for cutting weeds along the roadside and clearing vines off the front porch of the store. We will hang a large **banner** on the cleared off porch, after the closing, letting everyone know the property is the future home of Purvis Store Market. And, thanks to **Alec Pendaleon**, an Esmont Friend, for assisting in getting a \$500 grant from Allstate Foundation.

Many thanks also to the **53 of you who voted** on the Esmont History Book cover. **#1 was the winner!** It is the full picture of the P.O. Building and I asked the designer to use a less ornate font. The back cover will be the one showing a map and a box of narrative. We will be proud of the book AND of the companion piece, an 11x17 poster of a map done especially for us by **Erik Irtenkauf**, showing the locations of the large Esmont Farms with their names, and it will appear in the book. Erik and **Dave Johnson**, an Esmont resident who organized all the pictures for the book, some of which he took himself, are putting the finishing touches on the map.
