"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean. Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of dead men's bones and everything unclean. In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness" (Matt. 23:25-28).

It is easy to fall into the trap of thinking that a few less vices and a little more church on Sunday mornings is enough to be Christian. The problem is that it is in fact a trap. Being Christian is not about avoiding vices and attending worship. In fact in many ways it's the opposite. God calls us to live into our greater potential. This means that rather than trying to avoid vices, we should be working toward building virtues such as charity, patience, honesty, humility, mercy and justice. It is about creating positive changes not avoid negatives. At its core, Christianity is about love of God and love of neighbor. Our vices typically have little to do with our love of God or neighbor unless our vices are taken to the extreme and destructive levels. In order to be an "on fire" Christian then we need to stop using what we don't do as a measure of our faith and focus on the things that we do accomplish. Have you fed the hungry, healed or visited the sick, visited the imprisoned, clothed the naked, sheltered the homeless? Have you opened up your heart to someone outside of your close circle of friends and family and really cared for someone you didn't know? The world will know we are Christian by our love, not by our "clean living." It is time for us, for you to start thinking about being in mission to the world. Find ways to serve and to love, the people in this community beyond your usual friends. Serve your neighbors.

The dinner, which was a traditional holiday spread hosted by Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church of Milton, was a fun gathering and a big success.
