#### More Than a Sermon By R.A.

So where do I start? I guess I'll start when I left Oregon on the run, and the county sheriff's were on a manhunt for me because of the commercial burglaries I'd committed. There was a \$15,000 reward on my head and the police had just kicked in the door of my motel. When I came back to my room I seen that all of my burglary tools were lined up neat and in rows on my bed. I looked over and the drawer to my vanity was opened and all of my empty coke bindles, empty plastic meth bags, along with my spoon and several needles were also in neat rows on a white towel on top of the vanity. Yes, the police had me and they had taken pictures of my criminal paraphernalia. Just then my neighbor ran into the room and said, "The cops are looking for you. They just left." It didn't take a brain surgeon to see that I was about to get pinched!

I grabbed my get away bag and took off out the door. I was no sooner half way down the alley when the cops hit my motel. I wanted to run but I knew that if I did I would draw attention to myself so I casually walked down the street and hopped on the metro bus. I was headed towards the outskirts of Portland, with every fiber of my being screaming RUN! But instead I casually, once again, made my way out to the highway and began hitchhiking. I walked all night long and then realized, I would be running my whole life.

What I was running from was a ten year prison term. See, I had two criminal groups going on in separate areas and the state police had figured out that I was the ring leader of both of them. When these men were arrested and given five years each in the state prison, my friend's mom said to me, "Turn yourself in, all you will do is ten years at the most." As I continued to walk the freeway, her words from a few weeks earlier echoed in my mind. I was at war with myself. I never give up or surrender. Outlaws don't turn themselves in, outlaws run! At that moment I looked up and seen a huge mushroom cloud and thought "Great, now it's going to rain." And right then a Volkswagen pulled over and gave me a ride. As soon as I jumped in the car I thanked them for the ride and said, "It looks like it's about to rain." They answered, "No, Mount St. Helen just erupted." I think that was around May of 1980. What I am sure of is that Mount St. Helen blew her top the day I was running from that ten year term.

I started doing meth and cocaine when I was 14 years old. I was young is all I know, and at this point I'm now on the run. I made it to where my mom lived and like a true outlaw mother she had an idea. She told me, "Don't worry. Your real name is R.D., send away for your birth certificate and get an ID in your real name." So I did. I even went so far as to get a GED and a driver's license. In 1982, I left there where I was living and went to Utah where I was able to get a job at a wrecking yard pulling parts off of cars. One night I got drunk and drove a man out to Eureka so he could get his cloths from his ex-girlfriend. But when we got there she pulled a gun out and started shooting at us. We jumped in the car to take off but when we backed up we ran up over the edge of a hill and got stuck. I started to walk down the street to see if I could find some help when I ran up on a two ton dump truck. I decided to get inside and when I did I discovered the keys in the ignition, so I took off with it. The truck only went a short distance when the transmission went out. I got out and started walking, again. Soon I found an unlocked car at a farm house, I got in it and found that the keys were in it as well. So, I stole that vehicle too and ended up getting pulled over and taken to jail for, you guessed it, auto theft. It seems the car that I had stolen belonged to a Utah County Judge's wife. Ironically, when I went to court I stood before that very judge, and he told me, "No long haired hippie from Washington is going to get off that easy!" He planned on giving me five years in a Utah prison.

So, as I sat in the county jail there in Utah I turned to the Lord Jesus Christ and prayed every day. I promised the Lord that if He got me out of this mess I would stop all my sin, stealing, fornication, dealing drugs, drinking, smoking, cussing etc. It's funny how quick we are to realize our sin, and that we need to stop our sin, when we are in a situation where only the Lord can save us. In jail, I would read the Bible every day and pray for the Lord to get me out of that five year prison term. I didn't really understand everything that I was reading but I kept believing that God could get me out. Then the day came that I was to go to court and be sentenced. As I set there an elderly lady came in and spoke to the bailiff, and he pointed at me. She then turned to look at the judge, said something to him and went into a little room behind the judge's seat. Then the judge went in, and then the bailiff and the county attorney. My lawyer looked at me and said, "I'd better go and find out what's up" and he left. About 10 minutes later the elderly lady walked out of the courtroom crying, and then my lawyer came out shaking his head and saying, "It's a miracle, you're getting out of jail today."

Now remember, I'm on the run from a ten year prison term in Oregon. When I asked my lawyer what he meant he said, "That elderly lady that just ran out of here crying is the owner of the car that you stole. She asked me if you had any family anywhere and I told her yes, you had a sister in California. Then she turned to her husband, the judge and said, "You'd better let that boy go, today, to go be with his family or else!" On that day, I knew and believed the God of the Bible was true and real, and that He got me out of jail. There was no doubt in my mind, and even my lawyer said, "God performed a miracle in your life today." I was released that day with time served with the 30 days I was there in the jail. And probation that would be transferred to California. Unfortunately, I got out of jail, got drunk and started smoking again. Two of my main promises to God were already broken.

I wasn't supposed to leave Utah until they could transfer my probation but because it was the Thanksgiving holiday they allowed me to leave for two weeks. So I called my sister in California and she bought me a bus ticket to Phoenix where I would change buses to get to California. Along with the bus ticket my sister sent me some cash so that I could get some food and smokes. But instead I bought booze and weed, and that fast I broke a third promise to God of not doing drugs. After I got on the bus I met a girl and we started partying and eventually making out. The bus made a stop in a little town in Arizona for an hour, so we walked up the street to a high school, I broke into the basement there where we were all alone. We smoked some pot and fornicated. Once we got back on the bus and it took off I realized I'd dropped my weed in the basement of that high school. So now I'd broken promise number four, that I would not fornicate any more. Basically I'd failed the Lord even though He had gotten me out of jail and proven to me that He was real. I didn't keep up my end of the deal.

Believe me, I'm going somewhere with this ...

Once I got to California, I figured I would just take the bus back the same way so I could get the weed I'd lost in the high school, but when I did the bus went a different way. It went up through Las Vegas and into Utah. Once back in Utah probation transferred me back to California, but it took a week. When I was finally done and could leave Utah my sister didn't have the money for a bus ticket. So I got a ride with a truck driver. I told him about that small town in Arizona, and the high school down the street. When I asked him if he was going that way and would he stop there, he said, "Yes, it's on my way." But when we stopped at the that store/gas station/bus stop in that small town in Arizona, there was no high school to be seen. The store was the same, but there was an empty lot where the high school should have been. At that point and time, I was scared and thought that some evil curse was now on my life because of all my broken promises to God.

I would get off of drugs and stay clean only by going to church and attending A.A. meetings but I never would fully surrender and give Jesus my whole heart and life. So needless to say, I would always go back to using drugs, dealing and sex addiction. Then I ran from California to Lake Tahoe, and then to Las Vegas. From Vegas back to Los Angeles and then over to Prescott, Arizona. In Prescott, I got clean again and started a roofing company. I did okay for about six years, but because I would not fully surrender to Jesus Christ, again I started using drugs and dealing. From 2006 to 2008, I had two arrests for transportation of dangerous drugs for sale, meth. In 2008, I was looking at 20 years flat. On my second count the sentence was ten year mitigated; fifteen years presumptive; and twenty years max.

At that point the Lord spoke to my heart and said, "Robert, you deserve 20 years in prison. You have been a meth dealer since you were 14 years old. But, if you will take the 10 year term, I will save you and show you mercy." That's when I surrendered to the Lord for the first time ever in my life. Did you just see that the Lord said 10 years? God is not mocked, whatever a man sows, that he will also reap! The 10 year sentence I deserved from Oregon finally caught up with me. I must now pay the piper.

In prison, I followed the Lord fully. He told me, "Give up everything. No T.V., no card games, worldly music etc. Spend all of your time in the Word of God and prayer." So I got the Bible on CD. I've listened to the Bible over 130 times. Still today, I study the Bible, listen only to the Bible and Christian music ... and a lot of prayer to pass my time. In 2012, I started a Bible study in Yuma, six days a week. There were between 20 and 30 men each night that would come and hear me preach. I was also training other men to preach. Early 2013, I got reclassed to come to this other prison. So, I turned that Bible study over to the faithful men that came each night there. On the night before I was to leave that yard, I was about to go to sleep, when the Lord spoke to my heart and said, "Ninety Days."

So I marked my calendar, July 2013. And I waited with anticipation for the day to come. When that day came, it was the first day I had the opportunity to go outside the prison to work as a trustee. Of all jobs, my job was in St. Johns. Four days a week we would go to St. Johns to the Annex building and court house to clean the bathrooms, vacuum, take out the trash and fix the broken things there. At that point, I thought the fulfillment of the 90 days meant that I would be partly free, working outside the prison. Excited about that I quickly forgot about the word God gave me, like I said, I figured it was fulfilled.

#### Here it comes ...

About three or four weeks went by and one day I'm in the basement of the Annex building doing some cleaning and my boss said, "Go to the truck and get me a screwdriver." So I went out the backdoor of the basement, and all of a sudden it felt as though I had been there before. Then I thought that I'd seen this place in a dream, because I see things in my dreams that come true. So I got the screwdriver and I took it to my boss. When we were finished my boss asked me to wait for him in the truck. As I'm sitting in the truck, I'm looking at the front of the Annex building and I notice that up above it says 'High School'. Then I looked down the street and low and behold there was the store and the gas station where my bus had made a one hour stop all those years ago. This building was the exact place where I had sinned with that girl, and broke my promise to the Lord.

You will be happy to hear though that I have been doing what you had suggested to me while I was in the county jail. I was made the worship leader of our yard, faith based church, shortly after my arrival here. In the Operconners for Christ newsletter, I saw that my song "Singing to My Lord" was published. That really made me feel good knowing that you all thought it was good enough to print. I long to watch as people go around in circles trying to find a way to escape through drug use. Everyone on the yard knows that I do NOT support that

lifestyle and show me respect by keeping it away from me. Whenever someone wishes to give sober living a try I'm blessed to be able to help them. Many have warned me that I am going to get burnt, but yet I refuse to NOT try and bring some light to this dark place. In one of our first letters, I spoke about feeling very abandoned by not only my family and friends but the world also. I am happy to report though that I am in no way feeling the same. Instead, I have been blessed to have found my way into a truly close and genuine relationship with my Lord Jesus Christ. And currently I am working my way through the Maximized Manhood book and finding it to be very helpful and making a true impact on my way of thinking. The relationship between me and my family has gotten so much better that it is nothing short of a miracle. After over ten years of not speaking with my brother he has said that he is willing to communicate with me AND work on our relationship ... D.K.J.

I'm sure you all have heard the saying 'Life's a Bowl of Cherries - But I got all the pits'. Now look at that phrase and think how God must feel when you say that. Well, I'm here to tell you that "God does not make any trash!" No one's life is perfect except God's. May the Shalom of heaven be poured out abundantly on Living Word Bible Church and of course the entire  $\mathfrak{OC} \mathfrak{C} \mathfrak{C} \mathfrak{C}$  staff.

There's vehement comparatives between the days spoken in *Isaiah 59:1-15* and our present day. You go ahead and read those Scriptures for yourselves. Then in *Isaiah 59:16*, "He saw that there was no man, And wondered that there was no intercessor; Therefore His own arm brought salvation for Him; And His own righteousness, it sustained Him." Then in Isaiah 63:5, again God, "I looked, but there was no one to help, and I wondered That there was no one to uphold; Therefore My own arm brought salvation for Me; And My own fury, it sustained Me." His awe at their, and unfortunately, still our delinquency continues.

If you wonder how effective fervent prayer moves God, just read prayerfully the words of God here in Ezekiel 22:21-31, "Again the word of the LORD came to me: "Son of man, say to the land, 'You are a land that has not been cleansed or rained on in the day of wrath.' There is a conspiracy of her princes within her like a roaring lion



tearing its prey; they devour people, take treasures and precious things and make many widows within her. Her priests do violence to my law and profane my holy things; they do not distinguish between the holy and the common; they teach that there is no difference between the unclean and the clean; and they shut their eyes to the keeping of my Sabbaths, so that I am profaned among them. Her officials within her are like wolves tearing their prey; they shed blood and kill people to make unjust gain. Her prophets whitewash these deeds for them by false visions and lying divinations. They say, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says' - when the LORD has not spoken. The people of the land practice extortion and commit robbery; they oppress the poor and needy and mistreat the foreigner, denying them justice. I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one. So I will pour out my wrath on them and consume them with my fiery anger, bringing down on their own heads all they have done, declares the Sovereign LORD." Yet through Moses' intercessions their nation was saved over and over. In Psalm 106:23 God's Word states, "So He said He would destroy them - had not Moses, His chosen one, stood in the breach before Him to keep His wrath from destroying them."

We are so blessed to have overcome instructions such as found here in *Hebrews 4:16*, "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." How powerful prayer is! Prayer can bring God's angel's rushing to back our faith phenomenally! (Also read 2 Kings 6:15-17 and Daniel 10:13) Angel's eagerly await deployment. "Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?" (Hebrews 1:14)

It's true, satan's hold on lives can be shattered. How? Ephesians 6:18 states, "praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints" The word 'perseverance', in the Merriam Webster's Dictionary is explained; (as in an undertaking) in spite of difficulties. To God a miracle is just another one of His works. That's why Jesus called His miracles as 'works'. Look here at John 9:4, "I must work the works of Him who sont Mo while it is day; the ntght is coming when no one can work." Now in John 10:25,32,37-38 "Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Mo .... Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me? .... If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him."

God doesn't always guarantee a miracle, but He is always listening for His will to prevail for His glory. Even Christ's disciples were perplexed when un prepared as Jesus explained here in *Matthew 17:21*, "*Howaver, this kind does not go out except by prayer and lasting,*" God's power through prayer will move prevailingly stubborn mountains. Mountains symbolize various difficulties, problems, illnesses and hindrances as seen above in *Matthew 17:21*.

We all will have to face mountains. But God does not intend for us to be stopped by them. We as Christian Overcomers are to accept them as challenges. 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As soon as I realized where I was, the Lord spoke to my heart again and said, "Today Robert, you have kept your promises to Me, and know that I am in control of your life. I am the One who has led you by the hand. I am the One who has brought you here. I am God Almighty, the Lord Jesus Christ." You see, out of all the prisons in Arizona, God brought me here. Out of all the town jobs that exist here, He placed me at Apache County in St. Johns. I believe that God did this to show me that I am in His perfect will. And in spite of the fact that He knew I would sin over and over again when He got me out of jail back in Utah, He still took care of me by showing me His love, grace and mercy. Every place that I chose to go in my self-will, the Lord was actually leading me so that He could save me in order to use me to further His Kingdom.

One of our greatest obstacles in our walk with the Lord is our inability to trust Him. Do we really trust the Lord Jesus Christ? If we do, then our faith and trust is seen in our obedience. TODAY, I am closer to the Lord than I have ever been, and I am seeking Him to change me by putting His desires, purposes and will deep within my heart. So much so, that it is all that I ever want.

Note ... When all of this took place in regards to stealing the judges wife's car in the fall of 1982. This prison where I'm at was not even in existence back then. They built this prison in 1994 just so the Lord could bring me here to show me His infinite love, power, grace and mercy.

I'll close with Acts 17:26-28 (KJV), "And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring."

Note ... The Editor is including Acts 17:26-28 (NKJV), "And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'"
