William C. Miller, 85, a resident of Oliver township for the past 56 years, died Monday evening at his home. He was ill with pneumonia for five days.

Mr. Miller was born on August 4, 1866, in Hagersville, Ontario, and was married to Mary Jane Jennings on July 1, 1890, at Rodney, Ontario. She preceded him in death six years ago.

In 1894 they came to Sebewaing where they resided for three years, then moved to a farm south of Elkton. After four years of farming they came to Elkton and purchased a livery which they operated for six years. Following this they purchased a farm south and east of Elkton, where they have since lived.

Surviving are two sons, Edward, of Oakland, California, and Ervin, of Elkton; five grandchildren; three great grandchildren, and a brother, George, of Bad Axe.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Evangelical United Brethren Church, with the Rev. L. E. Burgess officiating, and interment will be in the Colfax cemetery.
