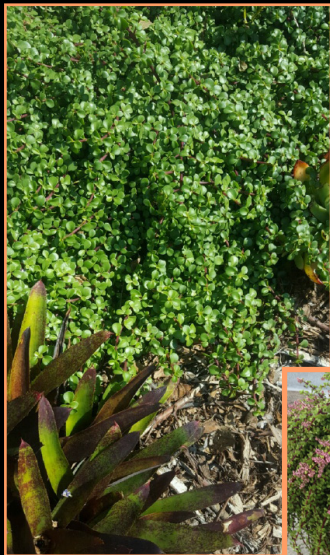


WwB (What Would Be) ... A GOOD PLANT RECOMMENDATION?



Portulacaria afra minima 'Emerald Elephant Carpet'

Seems every time you turn, you need a permanent, low growing, green shrub that is drought tolerant, looks lush in foliage, and is reliable for years of service. Doesn't that "get yer goat" that many are always suggesting the "Manzinitas (Arctostaphylos)" - which every time you've tried them in Southern California, they just slowly wither away, or completely die after just a couple of years? Well, if you're in a coastal, or inland-coastal area, where hard winter frosts are not an issue, then Emerald Elephant Carpet has small shiny green leaves, red twigs, and a nice mat-like habit, that is pretty much like all the Manzinitas hoped to be, but thriving in our salty water, warm summer soils, and under any watering conditions - from normal to very drought tolerant. This ain't your Grandma's ground cover! This is a permanent, durable, landscape succulent shrub, that will give decades of service. Can spread a couple to a few feet wide, rarely higher than 6" to 8".
