

Catch the Wind

32 bar Hornpipe for three couples in a four couple longwise set

Bars

- 1 - 4 1st couple set, cast one place (2nd couple step up on bars 3-4),
5 - 8 1st couple dance a half figure of 8 round 2nd couple.
9 - 16 1st couple set twice, 1st woman pulls back right shoulder to face out on bars 11-12,
1st woman, followed by partner, cast up round 2nd man and dance down to finish:
1st woman facing 3rd man, 1st man facing 2nd man.
17 - 24 Right shoulder reels of 3 across (1st man with 2nd couple, 1st woman with 3rd couple).
25 - 28 1st woman cast up round 3rd man and across the set to finish in 2nd place on own side
as 1st man dance down and cast up round 3rd man to finish in 2nd place on own side.
29 - 32 1st couple turn right hands.

Devised by Romaine Butterfield.

The dance was devised for Noeline O'Connor and Iain Boyd and the name refers to the fact that Iain courted Noeline for some time.
