## *EASY SLICED BAKED APPLES*

To make this recipe you'll need:

- Fresh apples
- [Coconut oil](#) or butter
- [Cinnamon](#)



### HOW TO MAKE SLICED BAKED APPLES... STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Preheat your oven and slice your apples to an even thickness of about ½ inch

Place baking pan into oven with oil or butter to warm and melt. Add apples.

Add [cinnamon](#), toss to coat, and bake.

The apples are done when they are very tender when poked with a fork or pairing knife.

**TIP:** You can also dice the apples before roasting if you prefer to have smaller pieces of apples.
