WHY IS THIS SURVEY IMPORTANT?

The Town lost eligibility for CDBG funding in 2020 after HUD data from the 2020 U.S. Census showed our low-to-moderate income (LMI) population at 41.7%, which is below the required threshold. However, this figure may not fully reflect our community. *It's possible the data includes the entire 99030 ZIP code rather than just residents within the Town of Rockford city limits.*

To regain eligibility, we must demonstrate that our actual LMI population exceeds 51%. The most effective way to do that is through this income survey. *Your response helps ensure our community is accurately represented and gives us the best chance to qualify for funding that supports local projects and improvements.*
