

Pioneer Woman Dies

Mrs. Elizabeth Carty Anderson, widow of George Anderson, died Wednesday night at the Rapson convalescent home in Pigeon.

A resident of Huron county for the past 80 years, she was born in Ireland on January 14, 1857. She came to the United States at the age of 16. She and her husband cleared 160 acres of land at Caseville. They moved to Pigeon in 1912, and her husband died in March of 1928.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the Shetler Funeral home. The Rev. Henry Manahan officiated, and burial was in the Colfax Cemetery, Bad Axe.

Surviving are three sons, William, of Sandusky, Arthur, of South Bend, Indiana, and Norman, of Elkton; four grandchildren, and seven great grandchildren.
