

Gibson Woods Wild Ones History

"Wild Ones" is a national organization whose headquarters are in Wisconsin. The Gibson Woods chapter was established in 2000, when several people gathered at Gibson Woods, eager to learn about the benefits of landscaping with native plants.

Gibson Woods Nature Preserve is noted for its high diversity of native plants. This made it the natural choice for the monthly meeting place of this newly formed group. It was only appropriate that the group became known as "Gibson Woods Wild Ones", the first Indiana chapter.

Many dedicated members of "Gibson Woods Wild Ones" have accomplished many things since that first meeting. One of the most satisfying has been growing native plants in Lake County Park's native plant greenhouse. Wild Ones members have become an important volunteer resource for the greenhouse by propagating native plants for restoration projects in the parks.

Our lives have been enriched and enhanced by these beautiful native plants and the wildlife they attract.
