### **Old Business**





# Dallas-Shreveport Road Historic Parkway

# September 28, 2024



Early one Saturday morning, sometime in September, a gaggle of Model A folks from the Autumn Trails Model A Club gathered at the local Whataburger in Mineola for breakfast and the beginnings of the Old Dallas to Shreveport Highway Tour. Me thinks there were about ten of us. Some were eating breakfast and others stayed in the parking lot kicking tires. After our fill of eggs and bacon and coffee (and the guys outside had told enuff tall tales) it was "Start your Engines" time.




We proceeded out the lot, around the loop and west on US 80, across the Sabine River to the top of the hill to the Old Grocery Store on FM 1253. There we met another gaggle of Model A folks from the Cedar Creek Model A Club and our official tour guide Elvis Allen. Elvis is a Texas historian and an expert on the history of the Old Dallas to Shreveport Highway.
