### **APPLICATION**

#### VERSATILITY REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

The NWHA Board has approved the adoption of eight (8) Regions for the purposes of NWHA Versatility Regional shows. Each Region contains generally equal membership numbers. An exhibitor is not limited to showing in just one Region. Exhibitors showing in approved NWHA Versatility Regional shows may earn the title of "Versatility Region Champion" as well as earn double points toward the NWHA Lifetime Superior Achievement Award and NWHA Versatility Year End High Point Awards.

Criteria for holding a NWHA Versatility Regional Championship Show are as follows:

- The show must be affiliated with NWHA and will need to review requirements for a DQP with the NWHA Director of DQP's.
- The show must pledge to donate \$2 per entry to NWHA. Revenues and expenses must be itemized and reported to the NWHA.
- NWHA requires the show to offer equivalent versatility classes that are offered at The National.
- Exhibitors at a show designated as a Versatility Regional championship show will be awarded double points for the NWHA High Point program and double points for the NWHA Lifetime Superior Achievement Program.
- Only one show per Versatility Region can be designated as Versatility Regional Championship (please review the states included in each designated Versatility Region).
- Double judged shows are not eligible to be designated as a Versatility Regional Championship show.
- Application to be designated as a Versatility Regional Championship must be approved by a vote of the Board of Directors. Applications submitted by September 1st, will be given priority consideration for the following calendar year.
- Due to the specific nature of versatility events, NWHA Guest Judging fees may be waived. However, the show manager must still submit a request for a "Guest Judge".
