Years ago, after reading this book, which had such a dramatic impact on me, I bought several copies and sent it out to my relatives and friends who had not yet invited Jesus into their hearts. Needless to say, there was backlash and some have not spoken to me since. Totally worth it to try to lead them to the Lord so He can save their soul from eternal damnation.

One of our sisters had a very realistic dream and message from Jesus which I would like to share with all of you. Here is her dream.

I was in a class, where my priest, dressed in priestly garments and a golden robe, walked around and taught us. He changed into Jesus from time to time. I was in awe of Jesus in him. He taught that although the devil could call each of us as owner of the world, he can only claim one third for himself. I also heard something like Revelation 9.

When I Googled Chapter 9, verses 17-21 stuck out to me which reads, *"The horses and riders I saw in my vision looked like this: Their breastplates were fiery red, dark blue, and yellow as sulfur. The heads of the horses resembled the heads of lions, and out of their mouths came fire, smoke and sulfur. A third of mankind was killed by the three plagues of fire, smoke and sulfur that came out of their mouths. The power of the horses was in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails were like snakes, having heads with which they inflict injury. The rest of mankind who were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshiping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood – idols that cannot see or hear or walk. Nor did they repent of their murders, their magic arts, their sexual immorality or their thefts."*

Sister continued, I asked Jesus what the dream was about and He immediately replied, *"It is a reminder for you not to forget that those who do not know Me, perish. For many still think that there is no last judgment, and certainly, no devil. But if there is no devil, then there is no evil either, and then everything is allowed. So, people make the world as they want it, without thinking about the consequences of what they do. Therefore, as your God and as your High Priest, this is an urgent wake up call, especially to the priests, that you show your spiritual children what it means to be Mine, and what it can mean if you remain caught in the clutches of the enemy.....certain Death!*

*"What shall I do with you, if you do not belong to Me, but to the devil? I have no use for you, I cannot take you to Me on the basis of free will. There is no space between the good and the evil in which I could let you dwell."* And here I'd like to add, at the end, God will destroy the influence Satan has on mankind, and if a soul does not know Jesus, then they will experience a similar fate as the devil.....one of eternal torment.
