RESIDENTIAL WALKWAYS

- * Reduce the amount of salt that you apply to your driveway and walkways.
- * Use snow removal tools and machinery (i.e. shoveling, plowing, etc.) whenever possible to reduce the amount of salt and chemicals used on properties.
- * Use only sand to provide traction.
- If you have multiple entrances to your home, designate one of them as the "winter entrance" and only maintain the walkway that serves that door.
