Preschool is now well underway, with the first month already behind us! Our students have had busy days full of playing and exploring various shapes and colours during the first part of September.

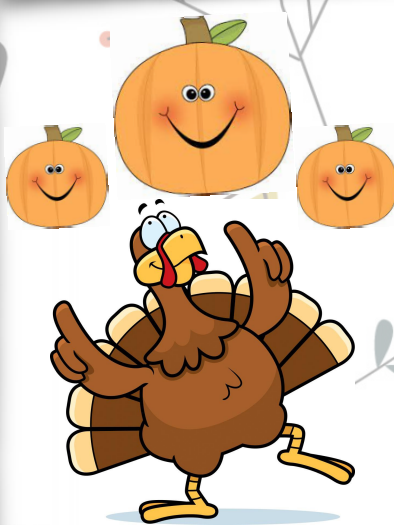
Classroom Theme:
