DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing Bear target recurve. Bubinga and Zebra-wood riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in good shape. Typical "yellowing" of the limbs. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed). Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$60 in 1964 (priced between the Grizzly and the Kodiak Magnum), which translates to \$589 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
