

TOWN OF MARBLE

ORDINANCE TO SET MILL LEVIES #6

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1992, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, FOR THE 1992 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Marble has adopted the annual budget in accordance with Local Government Law, on November 2, 1991 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$6,241, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Streets & Bridges is \$0, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Park expenditures is \$ 0, and;

WHEREAS, the 1992 valuation for assessment for the Town of Marble as certified by the County Assessor is \$959,400.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Marble during the 1992 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 6.505 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Marble for the year 1992.

Section 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Town of Marble during the 1992 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0 mills upon each dollar of total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Marble for the year 1992.

Section 3. That for the purpose of meeting all the Division of Local Government approved capital expenditures of the Town of Marble during the 1992 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0 mills when each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Marble for the year 1992.
