Meeting called to order at 9:23 am by President Gordon Ferlitsch.

December meeting minutes read and approved.

Safety: Mike Nason, When on a trail walk and experience gun problems, stay on the shooting line but step off to one side of shoot station while maintaining barrel direction down range.

Range: Jayson Kinkaid, Rifle & Trade Gun at 25 paces – 5 shots each. Pistol 25 paces – 10 shots. Trail walk 16 shots, pumpkins are for fun. H & K and Archery same as each month.

Spring Rondy: Jayson Kinkaid, Flyers were printed but need some changes/additions.
