The irony of history is that the arrogance, violence and greed still exist alongside the generosity and welcoming embrace of those who have seen the true light of the Christmas season. That light above all others, enough to light every town and city in this world, a light that is spread out as vast as the heavens above is the light of God's love. This is the greatest gift we are given this Christmas. This is the greatest gift we can give this Christmas. God's love. Our love for one another - all sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus.
