Proposition 1

On April 25th, 2017 voters will have the option to approve Spokane County's Proposition 1. Proposition 1 continues the existing 1/10th of 1% of local sales and use tax that keeps Spokane County's emergency communication systems and services functional. If Proposition 1 passes, Spokane County law and fire agencies will maintain the emergency communications system that integrates 911, Police, Fire, EMS staff, and Crime Check, as well as enhance the systems technology and capabilities.
