### Sacraments/Sacramentos

**Reconciliation/Horario de Reconciliación** Saturdays/Sabados: 3:30 pm – 4:30 pm

**Baptisms** — Baptismal arrangements must be made by the PARENTS of the child at the Parish Office. Parents and godparents **must** attend a baptismal preparation class before the baptism. Other requirements will be discussed at the initial interview. When choosing godparents, if they are married, they must be married through the Catholic Church, if single you must not be living with a partner. Donation is \$20.00

**Matrimony** — Weddings are celebrated throughout the year. In accord with Church Law, at least one of the parties to be married must be a member of St. Joseph, otherwise special permissions are needed. Marriage preparation is to begin at least 6 months prior to the wedding. It is strongly recommended that a couple planning to be married at St. Joseph contact the Parish before making any contractual arrangements with a facility for their reception. During the initial interview with the priest of the Parish, the couple will be provided with all the necessary information needed for their preparation experience.

**Anointing of the Sick**— Arrangements need to be arranged by a **family member** by contacting the Parish Office. Please indicate the status of the family member.
