Feast of Saint Olaf: July 29

Olaf Haroldson, who became King Olaf II of Norway, is celebrated on July 29.

A Leading figure in the history of Norway, he is remembered as a monarch who tried to unify the country and contributed to bring the Catholic faith to the land. As a king, Olaf employed his strength to Christianize Norway. In addition to building churches, he established "The Christian law" which prescribed that slaves be ransomed each year, forbade polygamy, and imposed penalties for rape and kidnapping of women. Faced with opposition King Olaf was compelled to fight, meeting his death at Stiklestad In Trondheim on July 29, 1030. One year later, Olaf was proclaimed a Saint and Martyr.

As a parish named after St. Olaf we will gather for Mass on July 29 @ 6:00pm. After Mass, cookies and refreshments will be available. **Saint Olaf...Pray for US!**
