Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and East District Commissioner, Garry McFee welcomed those in attendance and then Kyle Carroll led the group in prayer followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve the agenda and the minutes with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. Motion approve

Ed Riley Construction, \$19,948.80 concrete west side of building w/railing

Ed Riley Construction, \$3,874.35 Canopy

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to accept the bids from Thompson Electric, Flinn & Son Excavating and Ed Riley Construction. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the second. Carroll, aye, White, aye and McFee, aye. Motion carried.
