RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PREPARING THE EXHIBITS

- 1. Attend COE Creating Digital Files Workshop.
- 2. Download Creating Digital Files Workshop presentation.
- 3. Provide training to Self-Study committee members.
- 4. Create sample exhibits and share them with your team.
- 5. Each committee team prepares exhibits with the assistance of additional school personnel.
- 6. Exhibits to contain at least one document. For non-applicable exhibits, include a page stating so.
- 7. Make each exhibit readable and consistent. Follow the instructions provided in the workshop handout.
- 8. All administrative personnel and faculty must participate in the Self-Study and Exhibits creation, review, editing, and data collection.
- 9. Have draft Exhibits ready three (3) months before the scheduled accreditation visit.
- 10. Issue final Exhibits two (2) months before the scheduled accreditation visit.
- 11. The Team Leader reviews Exhibits and provides feedback during Preliminary Visit.
- 12. Make corrections to Exhibits as per the Team Leader's recommendations.
